

Brethren,

Since Conclave was last month, I thought it appropriate to provide a little history about DeMolay International and its close ties to Masonry. In January of 1919, a Mason by the name of Frank Land was contacted by the then Senior Warden of Ivanhoe Lodge regarding Elmer Lower, a Fellow Craft, who had died the previous year and his eldest boy, Louis Gordon. Louis Gordon, at age 17, wished to get a job to support his family while going to school. It was hoped that Frank would be able to provide that job.

After meeting Louis, Frank found him to be of particular moral character with good aspiration and scholarly habits. Not only did Frank offer Louis a job at his office but he later encouraged him to gather several likeminded individuals to form a club, a club that would later span the globe and be known as DeMolay International. Perhaps Dad Land's greatest contribution to the founding of DeMolay is the telling of inspirational stories on which the boys could build the foundation of their club to provide ideals to strive for. One of the stories was about Jacques DeMolay, the last grand master of the Order of the Templar.

Throughout the last near century, DeMolay has been closely associated with Masonry, including, perhaps least of all, the use of Masonic property to hold their meetings. More importantly, Masonry and Masons have provided advice and guidance while the young men decided the directions of their DeMolay chapters while learning how to become young men and leaders of outstanding moral character just like DeMolay's nine founding members.

Louis Gordon would go on to become a well-regarded city official as the Director of the Municipal Auditorium in Kansas City before his life was tragically cut short in 1943. Famous DeMolays include Walt Disney, Neil Armstrong, Dan Rather, John Wayne, Walter Cronkite, and President Bill Clinton.
