


Brothers, family & Friends,

There are no words for how these items have started to impact the students here at Red Bug Elementary. Our students have been hard at work creating. They are so imaginative with geometric shapes and build the best structures all while identifying 2D and 3D shapes. This will certainly help them visualize the attributes of the shapes during class instruction as well. Our 3rd-5th graders used the Edison robots to develop a robot that could deliver an item to a new location. This required planning and constructing a robot, coding the robot to move through a designated path, and revising their code. Our K-2nd-grade students have used the Code-and-Go Mice to create directional code. They even built bridges that the robots could drive over. Watching their problem-solving skills and communication skills develop with the use of these materials has been incredible. I am excited to see the impact that these materials will continue to make for years to come. Thank you again!





- 3. On the login screen, enter your temporary username & password:



- 5. Upon successfully changing your email and password, you will be required to logout, and then log back in with your new username and password. MAKE SURE TO WRITE THIS DOWN SOMEWHERE.
- 6. Once you have successfully logged back in, you will be taken to your Profile Page. Please verify all of your information on this page, and make any appropriate changes. You will also have the option to upload a current picture for your permanent ID card. NOTE: You must upload your picture within 30 calendar days of your first successful login, and no more than 60 days past your Lodge on-board date. Do's of uploading your picture:
- As high a resolution as possible (can be picture taken with smartphone/digital camera)
- No hats or sunglasses
- No other individuals in the picture
- No animals in the picture
- Your face should be positioned to take up as much of the photo square as possible
- 7. You may immediately begin to record your Masonic attendance, and take Master Mason I, II, III exams ONLINE
